

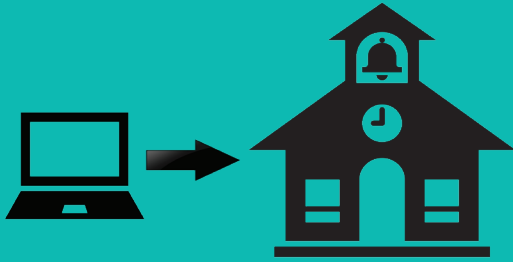

SAIL Remote

Yes! A SAIL registration form must be completed.

You attend SAIL while retaining home campus assignment.

SAIL has it's own set of GISD teachers.

Yes! You will need school supplies.

Uniforms are not required.

You can move on-site at the end of the grading period.
